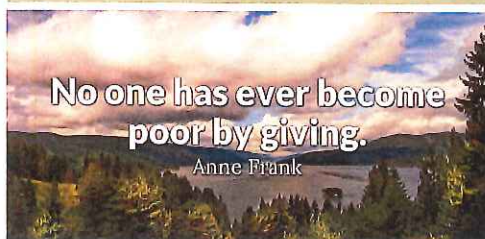
Notices
